LIONS HEAD SOUTH POOL RULES – 2021

- 1. The Monitor, Board of Trustees, Recreation Committee Members, and the LHSA Administrator have the responsibility and authority to enforce the 2021 Pool Rules. It is the responsibility of the homeowners to comply with these rules.
- Swimming is only allowed when the Monitor is on duty. The Pool Rules must be followed or it could result in removal from the pool area and revocation of pool privileges.
 NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY. Swim at your own risk.
- 3. **THUNDER AND LIGHTNING:** When thunder occurs, all individuals must leave the pool area. The pool area will be re-opened when conditions permit.
- 4. Restrooms shall not be used as changing rooms. Dripping bathing suits and bare feet are not allowed in the clubhouse and restroom.
- 5. Pool furniture must be kept at least six (6) feet from the coping of the pool.
- 6. FOR SAFETY REASONS: Place a covering on the chairs and chaise lounges.
- 7. **Resident Pool Badges are required for admittance.** When leaving, belongings must also be removed.
- 8. At all times members/residents and/or guests over 16 must display numbered plastic badges for admission to the pool area.
- 9. Children under 16 must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult and must be signed in. Children under the age of 3 are permitted in the pool area but, are not allowed in the pool during children's pool hours.
- 10. Floatation devices are not permitted. Styrofoam belts and arm "swimmies" will be permitted in the pool if an adult is in the pool with the child. Personal noodles, will be permitted, but must be removed upon leaving the pool area for the day.
- 11. Bathers must wear suitable bathing suits or swim wear. Cut-off pants or jeans are not permitted in the pool.
- 12. Saving of space will not be permitted.
- 13. FOR SAFETY PURPOSES: Diving is not permitted. Jumping into the pool is permitted when standing on the edge. There will be no sitting on the stairs or ladder. Lap lanes must be kept open for lap swimmers.
- 14. For safety purposes, there will be no sitting on the stairs or ladder.
- 15. No sprots, including ball playing or horseplay, will be permitted in the pool area. Children may have dive toys in the shallow end of the pool. Running is not permitted in the pool area. Excessive loud music is not permitted.
- 16. Pets are prohibited in the pool area.
- 17. Only non-alcoholic beverages, in plastic or aluminum container, is permitted in pool area.

 Alcoholic beverages are not permitted.

- 18. Snacks, in single serve "containers, are" allowed in the pool area. Food should not be shared with non-household members. All residents are responsible for cleaning their own area after eating. Picnic tables will be provided outside of the pool fence for anyone having sandwiches, subs or pizza, etc.
- 19. NJ Health regulations require showering before entering the pool.
- 20. Smoking is not allowed in the fenced-in pool area. Designated smoking areas, at the end of the sidewalk by the parking lot, must be used. Dispose of cigarette butts and other garbage appropriately.
- 21. Our pool maintenance company is Pool Operation Management.
- 22. All pool complaints or concerns regarding pool rules or non-conformance of duties by the Monitor must be reported in writing to the LHSA Administrator.

These rules are a protection of your rights, not a restriction of your rights, and are presented to ensure your safety and enjoyment of the community. Your neighborly courtesy is appreciated.

These rules shall remain in effect unless changed or superseded by the LHSA Board of Trustees.

These rules may be amended by the CDC and the NJ Board of Health.
